In this issue, we would like to introduce you our Italian made CNC workstation. The maximum processing size is 2400 x 1000mm and the minimum size is 100 x 100mm. Except for beveling and mitering it is able to all kinds of edgework. We will bring you more on the other equipment that we have in future issues.

Intex products are certified in several countries. In North America, Intex is SGCC certified for compliance with ANSI Z97.1-2004 and 16 CFR 1201 tempering standards.

In the European Union, Intex float glass, tempered glass and laminated glass are CE labeled. Intex laminated

glass and tempered glass are CSI certified in Australia and Intex mirror stock sheet is KS certified in Korea.

1. Acid etched Glass

Our maximum size for both single-sided acid etched glass and double-sided acid etched glass is now 48" x 96" (1220mm x 2440mm).
