New Intermac 3-axis CNC cutting machine

We bought a brand new high precision cutting machine from Intermac. It has 4 loading racks which allow us to stock 4 different stock sheets. We can make the best cutting yield selection immediately instead of having to replace glass packs.

This cutting machine not only cuts precisely but also automatically positions the template or glass samples. It can make CAD drawings by scanning the template if the customer does not have a drawing. We will start to use this machine in the middle of October, 2013.





Intex's Heat Soaking Oven

Heat Soaking is a process in which a pane of tempered glass is subjected to temperatures up to 280 C for several hours over a specific temperature gradient to minimize the risk of spontaneous breakage affecting tempered glass.

We own two high-efficient Heat Soaking chambers. The max size of the glass we can process is 5000mm x 2500mm.
