Laminated Glass and Screen Printed Glass

1. Laminated Glass

Although best-known for its tempered glass, Intex also produces and exports laminated glass and screen printed glass.

Laminated glass consists of two or more glass sheets with one or more layers of a polyvinyl butyral (PVB). In case any impact and breakage, the PVB will safely hold the glass fragments together.

Intex has produced laminated glass using domestic Chinese PVB and imported PVB. We also produce tinted laminated glass by using colored PVB. We currently use diffused white, blue green and blue PVB to produce "colored" laminated glass. Please ask us directly about our laminated glass.



2. Screen Printed Glass

Screen printing is a method of putting designs onto glass by using ceramic frit and a screen. It is also known as silk screening.

Intex is capable of screen printing both simple designs as well as more complex graphics. We can also screen print glass to achieve an Acid-Etched look at a lower cost. Please inquire if you have questions. Samples may be available.



Xiamen International Marathon
